

**WHAT IS SUREPRESS®?**

*SurePress is an innovative line of plumbing press fittings that visually confirms a pressed connection.*

**HOW DOES IT WORK?**

The SurePress difference starts with its patented design, which includes four to eight indication windows, depending on the size of the fitting. These indication windows are engineered to be visible from any angle, no matter which orientation the fitting is placed on the pipe. Once the fitting is pressed, green indication fills the windows to confirm a successful press, visible from five feet away.

**WHY IS THAT IMPORTANT?**

**1. Lost Time on the Jobsite**

If a connection is missed and not caught before the pressure test, the system will fail the test. Then the professional must:

- Isolate the issue(s)
- Walk the entire system and find the unpressed fitting(s) – **like a needle in a haystack!**
- Press it
- Re-run the pressure test

This could cost hours, especially on large or complex jobs.

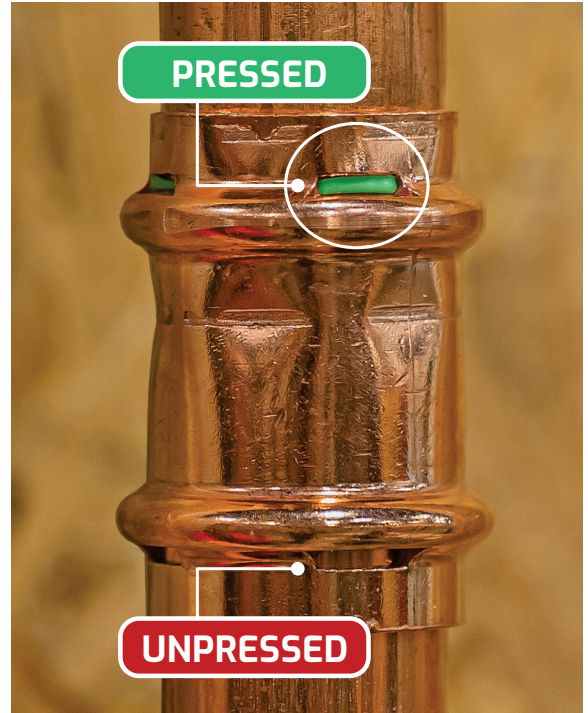
**2. Wasted Money**

Time = labor costs. The longer it takes, the more it costs. If the mistake is caught late in the day, it may delay inspections or push back other trades. In some cases, it can result in extra charges or penalties from the general contractor or client.

**3. Worst Case: It's Not Caught**

Some press fittings can hold a seal without being pressed due to the tightness of the fitting and the internal components making contact with the pipe. However, this seal will **NOT** hold under normal operating conditions, such as such as vibration, pressure changes, or temperature shifts. The fitting will eventually disconnect from the pipe, leading to leaks and system failure. This could happen days, weeks, or even months later — after the building is occupied. And the consequence?

- Water damage to drywall, flooring, furniture, equipment, and more
- Insurance claims
- Reputation damage
- Costly callbacks and possibly full system tear-outs



**WHAT'S THE SUREPRESS DIFFERENCE?**

SurePress allows installers to confirm fittings have been pressed as they install - **BEFORE** the pressure test. Simply press the fitting, see green, and go! Inspectors can walk the plumbing lines and see that the connections have been pressed from five feet away. This saves time and money on the job site and reduces callbacks, claims, and lost revenue.
